

## STURMER PARISH COUNCIL

#### 1. Amenity walk and play area Water Lane, Sturmer.

- a. description (what it is, including size/acreage). Disused railway line (Stour Valley Railway, closed in 1968) now converted into children's play area and amenity walk. 1.937 Ha in size.
- b. location ( address or description of location). Located on land to the west of B1061 (Water Lane) Sturmer. The land is a linear, straight strip located between TL69084435 and TL69794400 on OS map TL6844 & TL6944
- c. owner/custodian. Registered owner Sturmer Parish Council, registered custodian David Porth, Mere Cottage, Linnetts Lane, Sturmer, Haverhill, Suffolk. CB9 7XW
- d. date of acquisition. 1<sup>st</sup> November 1978
- e. cost of acquisition. (or proxy value). £850
- f. present use. Presently used as children's play area, amenity walk and cycleway.

#### 2. Sturmer Common

- a. description (what it is, including size/acreage). Registered common land (VG52 with Essex County Council) 1.86 Ha in size.
- b. location ( address or description of location). Located to the north of Coupals Road, Sturmer and centred on OS location TL 69184495 on OS map TL6844 & TL6944.
- c. owner/custodian. Registered owner Sturmer Parish Council, registered custodian David Porth, Mere Cottage, Linnetts Lane, Sturmer, Haverhill, Suffolk. CB9 7XW
- d. date of acquisition. Title registered on 7<sup>th</sup> March 2011.
- e. cost of acquisition. (or proxy value). £45 land registration fee only.
- f. present use. Presently used as common land.
